My dear Mr. Commissioner:

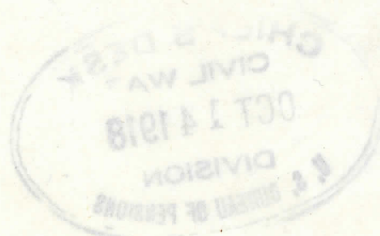
I enclose herewith a letter received from this
